At the end of the event, students had the opportunity to be included in an online group, which will facilitate communication between students, teachers, and college students and through which they will receive information on competitions and events organized for students, as well as information on admission to higher education.

Etapa a-II-a - FDI

I was a member of the project team entitled "GAUDEAMUS IGITUR – EQUAL CHANCES TO EDUCATION", code CNFIS-FDI-2018-0486, as an education expert. The project was funded by the Ministry of National Education, from the institutional development fund, area 1: increasing social equity, with a view to social inclusion and increasing access to higher education, linking educational supply with labor market demand (including those on career advice and guidance). The project was implemented between 08.06.2018–07.12.2018 and has a total value of 328330,00 lei. The fundingfrom the institutional development fund is worth 280,000 lei. The projectwas carried out in 30 high schools and supported a campaign that made the opportunities offered by equal opportunities for education aware. During the work visits that the project team had with students from rural high schools, they received advice and preparation for informed career choice. The visits were organized in educational institutions in the communes located in the counties: Constanta, Tulcea, Calarasi, Brăila, Ialomița and Buzău and have as main purpose the orientation of students to higher education and the University.

Activities to promote the educational offer of the "Ovidius| University in Constanta

In 2013 we designed, organized, and deployed the "University" Ovidius Caravan which has become a tradition of promoting the educational offer of the "Ovidius" University, which is reflected in different marketing strategies presented through educational caravans designed and carried out over the last five years (2013-2018). Each academic year the University "Ovidius" of Constanta designed and developed a project of promotion, information and educational counseling that focused within the Educational Caravan held for three months (February-May of each year) in 60 high schools in the counties: Constanta, Tulcea, Ialomiţa, Calarasi.
