Digital Forensic Team - DFT

[01/09/2023 – Current]

Digital Forensic Team is a project of the New Data Academy Association born both from the need to involve young researchers from Romania and Eastern European countries in the analysis of disinformation, malign influence or propaganda phenomena, and from their passion for research and analysis of digital data (digital forensic). The Digital Forensic Team is an international hub for the promotion and collaboration of researchers specialized or passionate in IT, database analysis and management, countering disinformation and propaganda, international relations, security studies, journalism, political science, European studies, sociology, history, etc. The results obtained by the <Digital Forensic Team> team of researchers will be put into practice at the societal level in order to strengthen the resilience of populations in Romania and Eastern Europe.

The main objective of the project is to improve the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office's understanding of the performance of the Countering Disinformation and Media Development Programme (both at portfolio and project level), and to generate an evidence base for effective decision making during the project's ongoing roll-out.

"MODEL PARLIAMENT - TRAINING THE LEADERS OF TOMORROW"

[01/02/2023 – 30/09/2023]

The educational project trains 200 young people from Romania for 6 months, combining theory with parliamentary simulations. The programme includes 15 theoretical modules, 5 parliamentary simulations and a final session in the Romanian Parliament. Graduates become part of the Model Parliament community, promoting Romanian-American values and civic engagement. The short-term goal is to educate young people in the areas of politics, history and countering misinformation, fostering future leaders. The long-term goal is to expand the Model Parliament concept in schools and universities to form active and informed citizens. The central objective is to promote civic and media education among young people to develop leaders committed to democracy, transatlantic partnership and human rights.

STOP FALS CORONAVIRUS

[15/06/2020 – 15/06/2021]

The project monitors all media channels in Romania with a focus on the phenomenon of disinformation and propaganda, focusing on the topic of Coronavirus and the influence of Russia and China. We will react to the most viral disinformation content and present truthful articles to the same audience, while implementing extensive communication campaigns on the most harmful content. We will create educational content about the disinformation phenomenon and ensure it is visible through a media campaign. At the end of the 12-month project, we will publish a study of our findings, which will be disseminated and included in the syllabus for a Masters course in Intelligence Analysis and Security Studies.

"FIGHTING MISINFORMATION AND INTERNET GROOMING"

The project involves the development of an applied, accessible digital textbook and the training of 12 teachers, who in turn will train students in their schools. The manual is written by specialists in the field of justice, communication and human trafficking. The handbook can be used as an important source of information in writing lesson plans for secondary school students.
